The incumbent will be expected to provide management support to the execution of strategic activities within the Division

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supports the development and implementation of communication strategies, plan public relations programmes, including the preparation of cost budget.
- Responds to enquiries from the public, and other organizations.
- Writes, edits, and arranges the production of newsletters, brochures and marketing communication.
- Assists in preparing organizational documents such as reports and corporate profile.
- Prepares visual aids and make public presentations.
- Oversees production of visual (film, video), audio and electronic material.
- Develops risks assessments and implements crisis and issues planning to ensure the organization's reputation is maintained.
- Supports the management and maintenance brand identity.
- Supports the development of product and corporate advertising strategies and material.

- Designs and implements a media placement schedule to ensure high visibility for the Division and its services.
- Procures promotional items.
- Organizes and manages staff and public events, exhibitions, conferences and product launches.
- Procures sponsorship of programmes as required.
- Coordinates and manages public outreach and education events, including lectures, workshops and conferences.
- Supports the Human Resource Unit in the orientation of staff.
- Supports the Human Resource Unit in the Development and delivery of internal communications.
- Other related duties that may be required.

MINIMUM EXEPERIENCE AND TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Experience (18 months to 3 years) in a similar role, in a Communication Unit, large Advertising Agency or Multimedia Consultancy. Qualifications as evidenced by a Degree from a recognized university in Mass Communication and Public Relations; or any equivalent combination of experience and training.
